

Attention Small Business Owners!

The Mississippi Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) is gathering information on the economic loss to small business owners throughout the state as a result of the COVID-19 outbreak.

MEMA is collecting this information so that Mississippi may request an Economic Injury Declaration from the Small Business Administration to aid in the economic loss suffered as a result of the COVID-19 event.

If you are a small business owner and have suffered an economic loss, please go to the Monroe County website, www.monroems.com or www.gomonroe.org and download the appropriate documentation that must be completed in order to receive assistance.

If you need assistance in completing the documentation, contact Monroe County Chamber of Commerce at (662) 369-6488.

Once the documentation is completed submit to the MEMA State Coordinating Officer Todd Demuth, for inclusion into the SBA declaration.

All documentation MUST BE SUBMITTED BY Wednesday, April 1st, 2020.
