

Monroe County Mississippi 2023 Accomplishments

M40 Airport

- Adopted a rates and charges policy to include flow amount fees for based tenants with their own fuel system.
- Awarded a Multi Modal grant to remodel our 60 x 60 hangar.

Building & Grounds

- Many hours spent during month of April recovering from March tornado. This included mitigating further damage and proceeding with bids and repairs to the Government Complex and Life Springs Ministry buildings.
- Building # 1 in Prairie new septic and additional restroom installed.
- Amory Health Department Interior remodeled including flooring and painting. Outside was pressure washed, parking lot cleaned and re-striped.

Building & Grounds

- District 1 Barn new septic chamber system with support lines installed.
- ■ Installed storage garage and slab at Life Springs Ministry.
- Chancery Building roof leaks repaired.
- ➡ Bartahatchie Community Center flooring restoration and dining area repainted.

Egii & Emergency Management

- Provided Emergency Operations supporting the recovery from March 2023 tornado in which over 1500 homes and businesses affected.
- Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP) was updated in 2023.
- Pole barn building to store mobil command center completed April 2023.
- ♠ EMA was awarded \$31,191.60 in grant money for the Emergency Management Performance Grant.
- Egii answered 19,753 calls in 2023. 156 new addresses were assigned.
